Identifying False Teachers	"Beware of pseudo-prophets who come to you in sheep's clothing, yet inside they are rapacious wolves! By their fruits you will recognize them.	<u>Mat</u> 7:15-16
	 Do they exhibit the biblical truth? Do they rather teach their congregations what they want to hear? How do they speak? The words of a teacher can ring with righteous anger but not with hate. The teacher must judge sin but have compassion for sinners. If there is no love in the teacher's voice, then he does not speak with the voice of THEOS. What is their reputation in the local community and family? Who are the teacher's friends? An upright teacher is rather friends with the poor and the powerless. Do they unify the church body? Do they connect or disconnect people from the local churches? Follow the money. Are they very rich? No prophet in the Scriptures was ever rich. How do they regard other leaders? Do they claim to have a special revelation? Do they try to appear superior to their listeners? Some claim an experience that 	
	elevates them to a "higher level," while others profess a more advanced spirituality that no one else could ever ac 11. What does my pastor think of those teachers?	
Should We Identify False Teachers?	there are overseers in the house of KYRIOS over any mad man who exhibits the behavior of a prophet, and you must put him into the stocks and into the neck iron [prison], and so then why have you not rebuked Jeremiah the Anathothite who exhibits the behavior of a prophet for you? Because he has sent to us in Babylon, saying, 'It will be a long time, build houses and live in them, and plant gardens and eat their fruit.' [] 'Thus says KYRIOS concerning Shemaiah the Nehelamite: "Because Shemaiah prophesied to you, though I have not sent him, and he has made you trust in a lie," [] I am going to punish Shemaiah the Nehelamite and his offspring	Jer 2 <u>9:26-32</u>
	Just as I urged you [] so that you may instruct certain people not to teach other doctrine, and not to pay attention to myths, which cause useless speculations rather than THEOS' plan that is by faith. But the goal of our instruction is love from a pure heart and a good conscience and a faith without hypocrisy, from which some have deviated, and have turned away into fruitless discussion, wanting to be teachers of the law, although they do not understand either the things which they are saying or the things concerning which they are speaking confidently.	<u>1Tim</u> 1:3-7

What's worse, they were not ashamed at all, and they did not know to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who fall; at the time of their punishment they will stumble," says KYRIOS.
