And all those who were designated for eternal life believed. [Predestination of the Nation of Israel, not of individuals!] ... when Rebecca conceived children by one man, Isaac our father - for although they had <mark>not yet</mark> been born, or done anything good or evil, in order that the purpose of THEOS according to election might remain, not by works but by the one who calls it was said to her, "The older will serve the younger," just as it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated." What then shall we say? There is no injustice with THEOS, is there? May it never be! ... What Israel [the nation!] was searching for, this it did not obtain. But the elect

obtained it, and the rest were hardened, just as it is written, "THEOS gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that do not see and ears that do not hear, until this very day." But when the one who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me [G2564, KA Λ E ω , kaleo: called loudly] by His grace For I came not to call [G2564] righteous ones, but sinners." Each one in the calling in which he was called [G2564] - in this he should $m{n}$. [...] Each one in the situation in which he was called, brothers -I am astonished that you are turning away so quickly from the one who

called [G2564] you by the grace of CHRISTOS to a different Good Message you were called [G2564] with one hope of your calling ... But we ought to give thanks to THEOS always concerning you, brothers dearly loved by KYRIOS, because THEOS has chosen you as first fruits for salvation by the sanctification of the Spirit and faith in the truth, for which purpose He called [G2564] you through our Good Message for the obtaining of the glory of our KYRIOS IESOUS CHRISTOS. So then, brothers, stand firm and to the traditions which you were taught, whether by spoken word or

by letter from us. Now may our KYRIOS IESOUS CHRISTOS Himself and THEOS our FATHER, who has loved us and given us eternal encouragement and good hope by grace, encourage you ... Therefore, do not be ashamed of the testimony about our KYRIOS, nor me his <u>2Tim</u> 1:8-9 prisoner, but suffer along with me for the Good Message, according to the power of THEOS, who saved us and called [G2564] us with a holy calling, not according to our works but according to His own purpose and grace that was given to us in CHRISTOS IESOUS before time began ... And for this cause he is the mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testa ment, they which are called [G2564] might [may / should] receive [clearly

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for THEOS' possession, so that you may proclaim the virtues of the one who called [G2564] you out of darkness into his marvelous light ... But if you endure when you do good and suffer for it, this finds favor with THEOS. For to this you were called [G2564], because CHRISTOS also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you should follow in His footsteps ... And finally, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, showing mutual affection, compassionate, humble, not repaying evil for evil or insult for insult, but on the other hand blessing others, because for this reason you were called [G2564], so that you **could** inherit a blessing. not certain in this context] the promise of eternal inheritance.

CHRISTOS, after you have suffered for a short time, will Himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen. And unless those days had been shortened, no human being would be saved. But for the sake of <mark>the elect</mark>, those days will be shortened. At that time if anyone should say to you, 'Behold, here is the CHRISTOS,' or 'Here he is,' do not believe him! For false messiahs and false prophets will appear, and will produce great signs and wonders in order to deceive, if possible, even the elect. And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather

His elect together from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other ...

And will not THEOS surely see to it that justice is done to His chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, and will he delay toward them? You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and your fruit should remain, in order that whatever you ask the FATHER in my name he will give you. Greet Rufus, the chosen one in KYRIOS, and his mother and mine. Therefore, as the chosen of THEOS, holy and dearly loved, put on affection, compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience ... I testify solemnly before THEOS and CHRISTOS IESOUS and the elect angels that you observe these things without prejudice, doing nothing according to partiality. ... a living stone rejected by men but chosen and precious in the sight of THEOS. And you yourselves, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to THEOS through IESOUS CHRISTOS. For it stands in Scripture, "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who believes in him will never be put to shame." Therefore the honor is for you who believe [...] you are a <mark>chosen</mark> race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for THEOS' possession, so that you may proclaim the virtues of the one who called you

And those whom He predestined, these He also called, and those whom He called, these He also justified, and those whom He justified, these He also

THEOS has not rejected his people, whom He foreknew! Or do you not know, in the passage about Elijah, what the Scripture says - how he appeals to THEOS against Israel? ... the precious blood of CHRISTOS, like that of an unblemished and spotless LAMB who was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has been revealed in these last times for you ...

"Israelite men, listen to these words! IESOUS the Nazarene, a man attested to you by THEOS with deeds of power and wonders and signs that THEOS did through him in your midst, just as you yourselves know - this man, delivered up by the determined plan and foreknowledge of THEOS, you executed by nailing to a cross through the hand of lawless men. ... elect according to the foreknowledge of THEOS the FATHER ... For in truth both Herod and Pontius Pilate, together with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel, assembled together in this city against your holy servant

IESOUS whom you anointed, to do all that your hand and plan had predestined to take place. ... those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His SON [...] And those whom He <mark>predestined</mark>, these He also called we speak the hidden wisdom of THEOS in a mystery, which THEOS predestined before the ages for our glory, which none of the rulers of this age knew.
