### **Prologue**

Many words could be spoken about sexuality and the physical, psychological and emotional effects on our lives. But this study will focus on the core issues which all too often lay in imprecise translations and erroneous interpretations. With minimal interpretation, it will systematically lead the reader through the biblical terms, definitions and applications of the respective words, what in turn will lead to the best understanding of the biblical concepts and will clear up a lot of confusions when it e.g. comes to the differentiation between fornication and adultery, or by even looking deeper into certain words such as 'zânâh' (Strong's H2181) and specifying its simultaneous use for adultery, fornication or prostitution, depending on the context.

This study should not only clear up misconceptions, but enable any pastor to preach solid theology on a topic that affects all of us, in the good and joyful - or all too often in the thorn that it brings to those who struggle in sanctification.
