'Two by two' is often interpreted incorrectly it can only mean 2 of each gender, because "seven by seven" (Gen 7:2) would otherwise result in 3.5 males and 3.5 females. The Bible does generally not count females and children (e.g. humans) nor is there an exception from this rule for animals.

Two of its kind: Noah did not need to bring e.g. both horses and zebras since these creatures are from the same kind - he just needed to bring two of the horse kind (see also Gen 6:19 "some of

We can certainly assume that the respective "two" had been of different species that resulted in cross-<u>breeds - exponentiating in the centuries after the</u> flood towards the species we still know today.

We know today that the distance moon-earth is constantly increasing (38mm per year) and that the earth rotation is constantly slowing down, which consequently means a slower rotation around the sun and possibly shorter days in the past (several minutes or up to several hours).

The gravitation of the moon attracts the water of the earth; a multiple amount of open flood water means that the moon would have drawn slightly closer (a theory).

Another theory is that the moon came closer to the earth before the flood, and that its increased gravitation would have (although to a minor extent) helped the the abyss waters to remain above the mantle of the earth for 150 days (!).

The Bible also informs us that this situation prevailed for a period of 5 months, and that an additional 7 months were required for the waters to subside sufficiently for Noah to disembark in the mountains of Ararat.

3. The expression 'fountains of the great deep were broken up' points unmistakably to vast geological disturbances that are incompatible with a local flood concept.

4. The construction of the ark with a capacity of at least 1.400.000 cubic feet merely for the purpose of carrying 8 people and a few animals through a local inundation is utterly inconceivable. 5. If the flood had been limited in extent, there would not have been a need for an ark at all, for there would have been plenty of time for Noah's family to escape from the danger area, to say nothing of the birds and beasts.

6. Peter's use of the flood as a basis for refuting uniformitarian skeptics in the last days would have been pointless, if the flood would have been merely a local one. 7. A widely distributed human race could not have been destroyed by a local flood.

8. IESOUS CHRISTOS clearly stated that all men were destroyed by the flood (Luk 17:26-30). The covenant, which THEOS made with Noah after the flood, becomes meaningless if only a part of the human race had been involved.

10. Evidence of human fossils in widely scattered parts of the world makes it very difficult to assume that men did not migrate beyond the Near East before the time of the flood.



While most of the building materials of the ark would have naturally disappeared over the course of ~5300 years, we still find a remarkable footprint of the possible ark. 
