| THEOS | Trinity (3 different Persons, 1 Head) | Biblical: THEOTES, as defined in Rom 1:20 and Col 2:9. | YES |
| | Modalism (3 Persons, different modes) | Rejection. | NO |
| | Arianism | Total Rejection of its denial of IESOUS being deity and the HOLY SPIRIT being THEOS. | YES |
| | Unitarianism (1 Person) | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | Virgin Birth of IESOUS; IESOUS had siblings. | Biblical. No prayers to Joseph or Mary. | YES |
| Bible | 49 (66*) Books, Greek OT & Greek NT | Endorsed. | YES |
| | 49 (66*) Books, Hebrew OT & Greek NT | Partial Rejection. Modern Hebrew (Masoretic) Texts are essentially different from original Paleo-Hebrew texts and manipulated in <1% of the Old Testament. | DIVIDE only over manipulations |
| | Inerrancy of Scripture | All accounts of Genesis, the Flood, Jonah in the big fish, et al, are true and happened indeed. | |
| | Interpolated and Manipulated Verses | Original Scripture is absolutely perfect and fully inspired, although written by human authors. But most modern Bible translations are far from being perfect, and Jews manipulated (2nd c. AD) and 'Christians' interpolated some verses. | YES |
| | Deuterocanonical Books (commonly called Apocrypha) | Total Rejection as Canon, to be printed in any Bible, to be reproduced online or to be read in church. | |
| Calendar | | Exception: The 107 verses missing in Esther, and the 7 add. verses to Psalms are part of the Bible! | |
| | Heretical Books, Pseudepigrapha | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | New Year with spring (Mar / Apr) | Biblical. It is good to remember this day (Abib 1). | NO (Rom 14:5) |
| | New Year in autumn (Sep / Oct) | Unbiblical; Erroneous dating and misapplication through Jewish Mainstream. | YES (False Sabbaths) |
| Creation | New Year in winter (Jan) | Unbiblical; Pagan concept. Distortion of the originally biblical concept of a New Year. | |
| | Celebration of 7 Ceremonial / Extra-ordinary Sabbaths / Holy Feasts Days | Ceremonial Law; Most festivals required the temple & sacrifices. | YES |
| | | Resurrection & Pentecost are good to remember. | NO (Rom 14:5) |
| | Special Creation (7 literal 24-hour days; -5500 BC) | Biblical. | |
| | Atheistic Evolution (Big Bang & cells) | Total Rejection. IESOUS CHRISTOS created the world (Heb 1:3) and was not a bystander. | YES |
| Eschatology | Theistic evolution (THEOS created only cells; He ignited and guided Evolution) | Total Rejection. No billion-fold death before Adam. | |
| | Old Earth Creation (OEC) | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | Old Earth-Young Creation (OEYC) | Endorsed (NO creation before Adam, 'only' the planet and deep waters the SPIRIT hovered over). | |
| | Young Earth Creation (YEC) | Incomplete and romanticized teaching; Disregards the foundation of the earth; Creation is young, but not the bare planet itself. | NO |
| | Preterism (all events in -70 AD) | Total Rejection. | |
| Family | Historicist (Progressive fulfillment throughout history) | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | Amillennialism (1000 years right now; Revelation = only parables; no prophecy) | Total Rejection. | |
| | Futurist, Premillennialism | Biblical. | |
| | · Pre-Tribulational Rapture | Rejection. Rather wishful thinking; not biblical. | NO (Do rather not divide over those issues) |
| | · Mid-Tribulational Rapture | Biblical. | |
| Israel | Futurist, Postmillennialism | Rejection. | |
| | Judgment of unbelievers and believers | Biblical (Unbelievers & False believers to Gehenna; No condemnation but rewards for true believers). | YES |
| | New Jerusalem will be a real place on a renewed earth | Biblical. | NO |
| | Redemption of Spiritual & Tribal Israel | Biblical. But not all ethnical Israel. Luk 3:8. | |
| | Replacement theology | Biblical. | NO |
| Law | Christians are the 'Spiritual Israel'. | Rejection. When CHRISTOS will come back, He will take away the veil and set free many Jews who currently reject Him, and craft them once again into the same 'Olive Tree' His church is currently crafted in. | YES |
| | Judaism, Ancient | Biblical. Christianity is a perfect continuation of biblical, ancient Judaism. | |
| | · Beta Israel / Ethiopian Jews (~6th c. BC) | Biblical - if they accepted CHRISTOS as MESSIAH. | |
| | · (Ultra-) Orthodox (end 18th/19th c. AD) | Rather Biblical - some accepted CHRISTOS. They best preserved Ancient Judaism in Ethiopia and have no purgatory, Talmud or Mishna. | |
| | · Conservative Judaism (-1883 AD) | Rejection - they reject CHRISTOS and the NT, usually use the heretical Talmud & Mishna, Purgatory, 600+ OC Laws ... | |
| Movements | · Reformed Judaism (-1810 AD) | Rejection - they reject CHRISTOS and a future resurrection. But no use of Talmud & Mishna. | |
| | · Reconstructionist Judaism (-1925 AD) | Total Rejection. They reject THEOS. | YES |
| | · Humanistic Judaism (1964 AD) | Rejection. They teach 600+ OC Laws & Talmud. Originally deeply entrenched in Freemasonry. | |
| | · Messianic Judaism (-1813 / 1965 AD) | | |
| | New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) | | |
| Religions / Denominations (Abrahamic only) | Progressive Christianity | Total Rejection. | |
| | Prosperity G-spel | Total Rejection. Good Christians can be poor. | |
| | Arianism | Partly correct: CHRISTOS is long ago begotten in personhood, while eternal in His divine essence (no contradiction to THEOTES / Trinity), but ... | YES |
| | Arminianism | Total rejection of its evil fruit: -CHRISTOS is divine, but not fully deity -HOLY SPIRIT is neither divine nor deity- | |
| | Calvinism (Augustinianism, derived from Manichaeism) | Partial Rejection. Most doctrines are biblical. False dichotomy that we ought to decide between this and Calvinism. | NO |
| Salvation | Catholicism (Roman) | Total Rejection. False Religion. But there are some individual and sincere believers in the Catholic church. | |
| | Islam | Total Rejection. Largely plagiarized from Christianity (especially the Old Testament) and founded ~500 years after the NT was finalized in 120 AD. With a similar Abraham, but a distorted Father, Christos (Isa) and Mary, but a distorted Son, through the faked G-spel of Barnabas'. | |
| | Jehovah's Witnesses | Total Rejection. Evil Cult. | |
| | Mormons | Total Rejection. Evil Cult. | |
| | New Age | Total Rejection. False Religion. | |
| Spiritual Gifts | Pentecostalism | Total Rejection. Principal instigator of the Prosperity G-spel; brought forth many heretical teachers and apostles. | |
| | Seventh Day Adventists | Total Rejection. Cult-like. Many heretical doctrines. Additional laws to the Weekly Sabbath. | |
| | Unification Church | Total Rejection. False Religion; Evil Cult. | |
| | Eternal Security | Biblical Promise, but THEOS can (or rather will) retract if we reject Him. | (YES) |
| | Faith Alone | Total Rejection. Not required for Past, Present & Future Salvation. | NO |
| Baptism | Free Will | Biblical. | |
| | Grace Alone | Biblical Concept, but not as stand-alone teaching: Grace precedes Past & salvation which involves the cons of standing with God and only in combination with Free Will. | NO |
| | Predestination | Total Rejection. Not required for Past, Present & Future Salvation. | |
| | Hell (Gehenna), Physical, eternal | Biblical. | YES |
| | Hell (Gehenna), Metaphorical, not eternal | Total Rejection. | |
| Communion | Salvation for every CHRISTOS, offer available for 'elect' only (Calvinism) | Biblical. | YES |
| | Salvation through any religion | Total Rejection. | |
| | Shipwrecking of Faith, Possibility | Biblical. | YES |
| | Once Saved Always Saved | Rejection. Eternal security is the promise, but we can clearly shipwreck our salvation. | |
| | Single-Tense-Salvation | Rejection (The Bible teaches Past-, Present- and Future Salvation). | NO |
| Head Coverings | Single-Tense-Justification | Past- and Future Justification; see study. | |
| | Works of the Law | Total Rejection. Not required for Past, Present & Future Salvation. | |
| | (Atonement, Circumcision, Clean Food, Sabbath) to get right with THEOS | Total Rejection. Not required for Past, Present & Future Salvation. | YES |
| | Works of Faith, Love (Society) = works after being brought into contact with THEOS | Biblical. Not required for Past Salvation - then even judged and rewarded! | |
| | Faith Alone | Total Rejection. Do not quench the SPIRIT nor undermine the functions within a church. | |
| Sabbath, Weekly | Cessationism | Total Rejection. Do not quench the SPIRIT nor undermine the functions within a church. | |
| | Continuationism | Biblical (But redressing of the Robertsonian heresy and of Preterism / Futurism / Dispensationalism) | (YES) |
| | Tongues as a sign required for demonstrating Past Salvation | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | Important symbols of obedience | Biblical. See 1Cor 11:2-16 | |
| | Optional for Past Salvation ('Born Again') | Biblical: can either accompany or possibly succeed Past salvation shortly thereafter. | YES (Salvation issue) |
| Giving | Optional for Future Salvation | Total Rejection (With possible exceptions). | |
| | Baby Blessing | Biblical. Ideally in private and primarily alone through the father of the child. | |
| | Infant Baptism | Endorsement of baptizer but baptism and rejection speculate and judgment about what THEOS did not stipulate. Age of Accountability = 20 years! | NO |
| | Lord's Supper / Christian Communion | Joh 6:53 salvation describes it as a requirement for future salvation. Scribes it with or without alcohol. | (NO) |
| | Free-will Giving | Bread with or without leaven. | |
| Head Coverings | Tithing | Biblical: 10% can be a vague orientation - Distributed btw. the poor / church / ministries. | NO |
| | Men should not pray with head covering. | (Old Covenant Law: Rejection of 'Works of the Law'). | |
| | Men should pray with head covering. | Biblical. We are the first apostate generation(s). Paul practically over 2 more authority implications: 1. Create. 2. Create. 3. Angels. 4. Biblical tradition | |
| | Saturday (Sunset Friday-Sunset; Jewish Mainstream) | Not Biblical (Timing based on 2 out of 7 Feast Sabbaths), but possibly acceptable to THEOS. | |
| | Saturday (Sunrise-Sunrise Sunday) | Biblical. Weekly Sabbath. | NO |
| Sabbath, Weekly | Sunday (First Day, 'Lord's Day') | Rejection. It is a direct- product of anti-Semitism; see the study. | |
| | Any Day Sabbathism | Total Rejection. | YES |
| | Any Day Sabbathism | Total Rejection. | |
| | Metaphorical Sabbath (Future rest only) | Total Rejection. | |
| | * originally 60 books - the modern count is 66 books (10 OT books reckoned as five are now double; 12 Minor Prophets as one book; see study 'Canon') | | |
