



Introduction

Prologue

Scripture points to IESOUS CHRISTOS and recounts his life on earth as well as past events from the perspective of Early Christians. In this study, I do not focus on the 300-575 prophecies and promises that scholars have claimed to have found, but rather on the 54 most important and impressive prophecies that foretell IESOUS' birth, death, and resurrection. Each prophecy is compared with its fulfillment, and corresponding biblical references are highlighted in green. The study is structured according to the timeline of IESOUS CHRISTOS Himself, making the prophecies easy to relate to.

-1406 BC

Moses wrote about IESOUS.

"KYRIOS your **THEOS** will raise up for you a prophet like **me from your midst**, from your countrymen, and to Him you shall listen. [...] I will raise up a prophet for them from among their countrymen like you, and I will place my words into His mouth, and He shall speak to them everything that I command Him. And then **the man that will not listen to my words** that he shall speak in my name, I will hold accountable.

Deu 18:15-19

Moses said, 'KYRIOS the **THEOS** will raise up for you a prophet like **me from your brothers**. You will listen to Him in everything that He says to you. And it will be that **every soul who does not listen** to that prophet will be destroyed utterly from the people.'

Act 3:22-23

-979 BC

THEOS would place IESOUS CHRISTOS as King over the whole earth.

"But as for me, I have set my king on Zion, my holy mountain." I will tell the decree; KYRIOS said to me: **"You are my SON, today I have begotten you** [IESOUS is the only person begotten by the FATHER]. Ask from me and I will make the nations your heritage, and your possession the ends of the earth. [...] Kiss the SON lest He be angry and you perish on the way, for His anger burns quickly. Blessed are all who take refuge in Him.

Psa 2:6-12

And we proclaim the Good Message to you: that the **promise that was made to the fathers**, this promise THEOS has fulfilled to our children by raising IESOUS, as it is also written in the second psalm, **"You are my SON, today I have fathered you!"**

The MESSIAH would be greater than the original 'tree' and would bear much fruit through His Kingdom.

When your days are full and you lie down with your ancestors, I will raise up **your offspring after you who will go out from your body**, and I will establish His kingdom.

2Sam 7:12

For to which of the Angels did He ever say, **"You are my SON, today I have begotten you,"** and again, **"I will be his FATHER, and he will be my SON?"** And again, when He brings the firstborn into the world, He says, "And let all the Angels of THEOS worship Him."

Heb 1:5-6

And a shoot will come out **from the stump of Jesse**, and a branch from its roots will bear fruit. And the SPIRIT of KYRIOS shall rest on Him - a **SPIRIT of wisdom** and understanding, a **SPIRIT of counsel and might**, a **SPIRIT of knowledge and the fear of KYRIOS**. [...] But He shall judge the poor with righteousness, and He shall decide for the needy of the earth with rectitude ...

Thus also CHRISTOS did not glorify Himself to become high priest, but the One who said to Him, **"You are my SON, today I have begotten you,"** ...

... He raised up David for their king [...] From the **descendants of this man**, according to His promise, THEOS brought to Israel a SAVIOR, IESOUS.

"Look, days are coming," declares KYRIOS, "when I will raise up for David a righteous branch, and He will reign as king, and He will achieve success, and He will do justice and righteousness in the land."

John the Baptist would prepare the way for the MESSIAH.

A **voice is calling in the wilderness**, "Clear the way of KYRIOS! Make a **highway smooth** in the desert for our THEOS!

Isa 40:3

For this is the One spoken of by the prophet Isaiah, saying: **"A voice of one crying in the wilderness. Prepare the way of KYRIOS! Make His paths plain!"**

Mat 3:3; 11:10

"Look! I am going to **send my messenger**, and He will **prepare the way** before me. And KYRIOS whom you are seeking will come suddenly to His temple, and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you are taking pleasure - look! - He is about to come," says KYRIOS of hosts.
