Belief

We form our belief through the ideas and concepts we gather while acquiring information and experience. The biblical 'belief' means to be thoroughly convinced of the Word of THEOS, and in particular of the existence of the Trinity and of the Evangelium (Good Message).

Faith without seeking Him constitutes 'only' belief.

*Now without **faith** it is impossible to please him, for the one who approaches THEOS must believe that He exists [1. **believe**] and is a rewarder of those who seek Him [+ 2. **action = faith**].*

Heb 11:6

Through the SON we believe in the FATHER.

*But IESOUS cried out and said, "The one who **believes** in me does not **believe** in me, but in the one who sent me ...*

Joh 12:44

*... You **believe** in THEOS; **believe** also in me.*

Joh 14:1

Belief in CHRISTOS is the starting point for forgiveness, righteousness / justification, salvation and eternal life.

*... through His name everyone who **believes** in Him receives **forgiveness** of sins.*

Act 10:43

*... by this one everyone who **believes** is **justified**!*

Act 13:39

*For with the heart **one believes**, resulting in **righteousness**, and with the mouth **one confesses**, resulting in **salvation**.*

Rom 10:10

*But as many as received him – to those who **believe** in His name – He gave to them **authority to become children of THEOS** ...*

Joh 1:12

*The one who **believes** and is baptized will be **saved**, but the one who **refuses to believe** will be **condemned**.*

Mar 16:16

*"Believe in KYRIOS IESOUS and you will be **saved**, you and your household!"*

Act 16:31

*Now if we died with CHRISTOS, we **believe** that we will also live with him ...*

Rom 6:8

*... everyone who looks at the SON and **believes** in Him would have **eternal life**, and I will raise him up on the last day."*

Joh 6:40

We believe in the invisible.

*If I tell you **earthly things** and you do not **believe**, how will you **believe** if I tell you **heavenly things**?*

Belief can move spiritual mountains.

*... **do not believe** every spirit, but test the spirits to determine **if they are from THEOS** ...*

*But they did not listen and they stiffened their necks, like the necks of their ancestors who did not **believe** in KYRIOS their THEOS.*

Faith

When we believe the truth with enough confidence to take action, we exercise faith (mainly based on evidence through general and divine revelation, and only partly based on blind trust).

Words show belief, while actions show faith. Faith without works is dead. It is simply belief and even the devil believes in THEOS.

Faith can also be defined as trust / trustworthiness and results in obedience / allegiance.

Biblical definition.

Now **faith** is the realization **[action]** of what is hoped for, the proof of **things not seen**.

Now without **faith** it is impossible to please him, for the one who approaches THEOS must believe that **He exists** and is a rewarder of those who seek **Him** **[action]**.

[Heb 11:6](#)

So KYRIOS said, "If you have **faith like a mustard seed**, you could say **[action]** to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

[Luk 17:6](#)

Consequently, **faith** comes by hearing **[action]**, and hearing through the Word about CHRISTOS.

[Rom 10:17](#)

... in order that your **faith** would not be in the wisdom of men, but in the power **[action]** of THEOS.

[1Cor 2:5](#)

Faith is built up gradually !

And having been aware, IESOUS said: "Of little **faith**, why do you converse among yourselves that you have no breads?"

[Mat 16:8](#)

... "I tell you, not even in Israel have I found **such great faith!**"

[Luk 7:9](#)

And the apostles said to KYRIOS, "Increase our **faith**!"

[Luk 17:5](#)

So the churches were being **strengthened in the faith** and were growing in number ...

In fact, his [Abraham] **faith** grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to THEOS. He was fully convinced that THEOS is able to do whatever he promises. And because of Abraham's **faith**, THEOS counted him as righteous.

... THEOS has apportioned **a measure of faith** to each one ...

... according to the **proportion of his faith** ...

Now receive the one who is **weak in faith**, but not for quarrels about opinions.

But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most **holy faith**, by praying in the HOLY SPIRIT ...

Faith is refined through trials.

... but I have prayed for you, that your **faith** may not fail. And you, when once you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

They were broken off because of unbelief, but you stand firm because of faith.

These trials will show that your **faith** is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold - though your **faith** is far more precious than mere gold. So when your **faith** remains strong through many trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when IESOUS CHRISTOS is revealed to the whole world.

Faith including works! Works are a necessary attestation of faith.

For in CHRISTOS IESOUS neither circumcision counts for anything nor uncircumcision, but **faith working through love**.

Thus also **faith**, if it does not have works, is dead by itself.

[Jam 2:17](#)

For just as the body without the SPIRIT is dead, so also **faith without works is dead**.

True faith does not even fear death.

[1] If anyone is going into **captivity**, into captivity he goes.

[Rev 13:10](#)

[2] If anyone is to be **killed by the sword**, by the sword he is to be killed. Here is the patient endurance and the **faith of the saints**.

[3] But others were **tortured**, not accepting release, in order that they might gain a better resurrection.

[Heb 11:35-40](#)

[4] And others experienced **mocking and flogging**,

[5] and in addition **bonds and imprisonment**.

[6] They were **stoned**,

[7] they were **sawed in two**,

[8] they died by **murder with a sword**,

[9] they wandered about in sheepskins, in goatskins, **impoverished**,

[10] **afflicted, mistreated**, of whom the world was not worthy, wandering about on deserts and mountains and in caves and in holes in the ground.

And although they all were approved through their **faith**, they did not receive what was promised, because THEOS had provided something better for us, so that they would not be made perfect without us.

By **faith** [Abraham] received the ability to procreate even past the normal age, ...

By **faith** Abraham [...] was ready to offer his one and only son, ...

By **faith** Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, ...

By **faith** Moses [...] refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ...

By **faith** he left Egypt, not fearing the anger of the king, ...

By **faith** they crossed the Red Sea as if on dry land ...

By **faith** the walls of Jericho fell down ...

By **faith** Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, ...

... Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, and Samuel and the prophets, who through **faith** conquered **Kingdoms**, accomplished justice, obtained what was promised,

shut the mouths of lions, extinguished the effectiveness of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong from weakness, became mighty in battle, put to flight enemy battle lines. Women received back their dead by resurrection.
