Past Salvation

(From The Condemnation Of Sin)

Past Salvation leads us to THEOS' forgiveness of our past sins and to a fresh new start as a child of THEOS. While Salvation is principally granted by grace, we are to honor this new life by continually following IESOUS and showing Works of Faith (not Works of the Law!). If we do this and remain in the SPIRIT, then '**Past Justification & Salvation**' anticipates the '**Final Justification & Salvation**', leading to the realization of the hope of eternal life described in Tit 3:7.

The 'Prayer of Salvation / Sinner's Prayer' can be a rudimentary tool to draw people closer to THEOS, but remember that the Bible does not teach us this man-made prayer, and that Salvation implies ALL of the follow steps :

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Righteousness

Righteousness means being in line with moral / legal standards. It means the grace of THEOS, to acquit someone from their wrongdoing and to accept him or her as righteous in His sight. Similarly to Salvation and Justification, Righteousness has also a past and future application. Christians are already declared righteous the moment they are born again (in regards of past sins), but not yet fully until they will have successfully walked the path of Righteousness / the road of Sanctification.

The biblical definition of Righteousness.	<i>And if a man is righteous and does justice and Righteousness, and on the mountains he does not eat and he does not lift up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, and the wife of his neighbor he does not defile and he does not approach a woman of menstruation, and he oppresses no one and he returns a pledge for his loan and he commits no robbery and he gives his bread to the hungry and he covers a naked person with a garment, and he does not charge interest and he takes no usury, and he holds back his hand from injustice and he executes a judgment of fairness between persons, and in my statutes he goes about and my regulations he keeps, performing faithfully - then he is righteous, and certainly he will live," declares KYRIOS.</i>	<u>Eze 18:5-9</u>

Past Justification

Justification (= making justice) is the outcome of a courtroom process, if the courtroom finds that such Righteousness is indeed present. We are **initially justified** through IESOUS' blood in the moment we are being born again, and the **Final Justification** will be the status conferred by IESOUS in the courtroom = on Judgment Day. While the overwhelming majority of scholars teach that Justification is a one-time action, the chapter 'Final Justification' at the end of this study clearly proves that there are two dimensions to Justification. It would actually be a surprise to find anything one-dimensional in the Bible, but our tendencies for over-simplification have sadly prevailed in today's teachings.

[...] For we consider a person to be justified by faith apart from the works of the law. [this verse speaks against Works of the Law only and not against Works of Faith; Luther interpolated 'by faith ALONE' and caused a scandal which continues today through the heretical reductionism of salvation to 'Faith / Grace Alone' while mostly ignoring the 7 above mentioned steps contributing to Past Salvation]</i></p> <p><i>Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with THEOS through our KYRIOS IESOUS CHRIST: by whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand [...] while we were still sinners, CHRISTOS died for us. Therefore, by much more, being now [clearly Past Justification] justified by His blood, we will be saved through Him from the wrath. 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Following IESOUS

Sanctification

(Present / Progressive Salvation; From The Power & Penalty Of Sin)

Sanctification means 'holiness'. To sanctify, therefore, means to make holy, to purify to gold, to strengthen and to perfect. Every Christian - if allowing the HOLY SPIRIT to do so- is being perfected in the image of IESOUS in a lifelong process.		
The effective work of the HOLY SPIRIT in and through us is a fundamental part of Sanctification.	<i>... open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to THEOS, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'</i>	Act 26:18

The term 'twenty years old' is found 32 times in the Bible (highly overproportional compared to other ages; only the numbers of 1/2/3/7 years appear more often; see also the addendum with a detailed analysis), clearly underlining the importance of this age. Possible Limitation!		
<p>To my knowledge, there is one passage, which possibly limits the salvation of children younger than 20 years to those children, who have at least one parent who is a believer. This passage definitely implies that there are unholy children, which in turn can be interpreted as unsaved children. This would mean that if a child dies before the age of 20, it is only saved if it has on the day of his or her death a believing parent.</p> <p>Ezra 9 and 10 in the Old Covenant tells us also that children born of foreign marriages were to be treated as 'unholy', resulting in this account in the separation of entire families.</p>	<p>And to the rest I speak -not KYRIOS- if any brother has an unbelieving wife, and she is pleased to dwell with him, do not let him send her away; and a woman who has an unbelieving husband, and he is pleased to dwell with her, do not let her send him away.
