	<u>49 (66*) Books, Hebrew OT &amp; Greek NT</u>	Partial Rejection, Modern Hebrew (Masoretic) Texts are essentially different from original Paleo-Hebrew texts and manipulated in <1% of the Old Testament.	DIVIDE only over manipulations	
	<u>Inerrancy of Scripture</u>	All accounts of Genesis, the Flood, Jonah in the big fish, et al., are true and happened indeed.		
	<u>Interpolated and Manipulated Verses</u>	Original Scripture is absolutely perfect and fully inspired, although written by human authors. But most modern Bible translations are far from being perfect, and Jews manipulated (2nd c. AD) and 'Christians' interpolated some verses.	YES	
	<u>Deuterocanonical Books (commonly called Apocrypha)</u>	Total Rejection of all 15 books as Canon, to be printed in any Bible, to be reproduced online or to be read in churches.		
		Exception: The 67 verses often missing from Daniel 3:24-90, the 90 verses often missing in Esther, and the 7 autographical verses to Psalms are part of the Bible!	YES	
Calendar	<u>New Year with spring (Mar / Apr)</u>	Biblical. It is good to remember this day (Abib 1).	NO (Rom 14:5)	
	<u>New Year in autumn (Sep / Oct)</u>	Unbiblical; Erroneous dating and misapplication through Jewish Mainstream.	YES (False Sabbaths)	
	<u>New Year in winter (Jan)</u>	Unbiblical; Pagan concept. Distortion of the originally biblical concept of a New Year.		
	<u>Celebration of 7 Ceremonial / Extra-ordinary Sabbaths / Holy Feasts Days</u>	Ceremonial Law; Most festivals required the temple & sacrifices.	YES	
		Resurrection & Pentecost are good to remember.	NO (Rom 14:5)	
Creation	<u>Special Creation (7 literal 24-hour days; ~5500 BC)</u>	Biblical.		
	<u>Atheistic Evolution (Big Bang &amp; cells)</u>	Total Rejection. IESOUS CHRISTOS created the world (Heb 1:1-3) and was not a bystander.	YES	
	<u>Theistic evolution (THEOS created only cells; He ignited and guided Evolution)</u>	Total Rejection. No billion-fold death before Adam.		
	<u>Old Earth Creation (OEC)</u>	Total Rejection.	YES	
	<u>Old Earth-Young Creation (OEYC)</u>	Endorsed (NO creation before Adam, 'only' the planet and deep waters the SPIRIT hovered over).		
	<u>Young Earth Creation (YEC)</u>	Incomplete and romanticized teaching; Disregards the foundation of the earth; Creation is young, but not the bare planet itself.	NO	
Eschatology	<u>Preterism (all events in ~70 AD)</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Historicist (Progressive fulfillment throughout history)</u>	Total Rejection.	YES	
	<u>Amillennialism (1000 years right now; Revelation = only parables; no prophecy)</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Futurist, Premillennialism</u>	Biblical.		
	· <u>Pre-Tribulational Rapture</u>	Rejection. Rather wishful thinking; not biblical.	NO (Do rather not divide over those issues)	
	· <u>Mid-Tribulational Rapture</u>	Biblical.		
	<u>Futurist, Postmillennialism</u>	Rejection.		
	<u>Judgment of unbelievers and believers</u>	Biblical (Unbelievers & False believers to Gehenna; No condemnation but rewards for true believers).	YES	
	<u>New Jerusalem will be a real place on a renewed earth</u>	Biblical.	NO	
	<u>Redemption of Spiritual &amp; Tribal Israel</u>	Biblical. But not all ethnical Israel. Luk 3:8.		
Family	<u>Marriage</u>	Biblical. Secondary option for Christians.		
	<u>Marriage, to Unbelievers</u>	Not Permissible. Existing marriages remain.	NO	
	<u>Singleness</u>	Biblical. Primary option for Christians.		
	<u>Divorce</u>	Total Rejection. Neither abuse, nor adultery, nor desertion allow for divorce, only the well-known concept of unchastity found out in the wedding night.		
	<u>Separation</u>	Rejection. Only allowed in the case of abuse, adultery or desertion, if an unbeliever is involved who makes the active decision to leave. Yet the marriage bond remains intact and restoration should always be the goal!	YES	
	<u>Remarriage</u>	Rejection after abuse, adultery or desertion. Only allowed after unchastity, or death of the spouse.		
	<u>Adultery (Involving a Marriage)</u>	Total Rejection. But no more death penalty.		
	<u>Fornication (Not Involving a Marriage)</u>	Total Rejection.	YES	
	<u>Homos*xuality</u>	Total Rejection. But no more death penalty.		
	<u>Abortion</u>	Total Rejection. Plain murder.	YES	
	<u>Contraception - Abortifacients</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Contraception</u>	Not unbiblical, but can later directly influence THEOS' favor if to open or close a womb, if previously done without consulting Him.	NO	
	<u>Complementarianism (Men &amp; Women are equal in dignity, yet complementary roles)</u>	(Rather) Biblical. Not defined as such, but clearly described as such.	NO	
		<u>Egalitarianism (Interchangeable roles)</u>	Total Rejection.	
	Israel	<u>Anti-Semitism</u>	Total Rejection of Anti-Semitism, found e.g. in Lutheranism and Roman Catholicism.	
<u>Replacement theology</u>		Rejection. When CHRISTOS will come back, He will take away the veil and set free many Jews who currently reject Him, and craft them once again into the same 'Olive Tree' His church is currently crafted in.	YES	
<u>Christians are the 'Spiritual Israel'.</u>		Biblical. Christianity is a perfect continuation of biblical, ancient Judaism.		
<u>Judaism, Ancient</u>		Biblical - if they accepted CHRISTOS as MESSIAH.	-	
· <u>Beta Israel / Ethiopian Jews (~6th c. BC)</u>		Rather Biblical - some accepted CHRISTOS. They best preserved Ancient Judaism in Ethiopia and have no purgatory, Talmud or Mishna.	(NO) (Tell them the Evangelium)	
· <u>(Ultra-) Orthodox (end 18th/19th c. AD)</u>		Rejection - they reject CHRISTOS and the NT, usually use the heretical Talmud & Mishna, Purgatory, + 600+ OC Laws ...		
· <u>Conservative Judaism (~1883 AD)</u>		Rejection - they reject CHRISTOS and a future resurrection. But no use of Talmud & Mishna.		
· <u>Reformed Judaism (~1810 AD)</u>		Total Rejection. They reject THEOS.	YES	
· <u>Reconstructionist Judaism (~1925 AD)</u>		Total Rejection. They reject THEOS.		
· <u>Humanistic Judaism (1964 AD)</u>		Rejection. They teach 600+ OC Laws & Talmud. Originally deeply entrenched in Freemasonry.		
· <u>Messianic Judaism (~1813 / 1965 AD)</u>	Rejection. They teach 600+ OC Laws & Talmud. Originally deeply entrenched in Freemasonry.			
Law	<u>Laws of CHRISTOS &amp; Apostles</u>	Biblical. We ought to obey.		
	<u>Moral Law (10), Eternal</u>	Biblical. We ought to obey 10 out of 10. It preceded Sinai by ~4100 years and every command had been enforced btw. Gen 1-Exo 16. IESOUS did not abolish the 10 commandments, but practised every single one repeatedly and looks now even at our intent!		
		Total Rejection of Catholic doctrine (6 out of 10), and of Reformed doctrine (9 out of 10).	YES	
	<u>Old Covenant Law (600+)</u>	Originally endorsed through CHRISTOS - Now abolished through CHRISTOS (except blood & unchastity as per Acts 15; Many principles are still useful & important, such as the prohibition of bestiality, forced slavery, incest ...).		
	<u>Oral / Fence Laws (1500+)</u>	Despised by CHRISTOS.		
	Movements	<u>Alpha Course</u>	Partial Rejection; Strong R. Catholic influence.	NO
		<u>Charismatic Movement</u>	Total Rejection.	YES
		<u>'Christian' / Catholic Mysticism</u>	Total Rejection.	
		<u>Ecumenism</u>	Rejection (With some exceptions).	YES
		<u>Feminism</u>	Rejection (Except the first wave; Total rejection of the third and fourth wave).	(NO)
<u>Hebrew Roots</u>		Rejection (Good to endorse the Weekly Sabbath; but erroneous affirmation of Sabbaths of Sabbaths and of Old Covenant Law in general).	YES	
<u>KJV Only</u>		Rejection. It is cult-like to force people from any nation to read a specific English Bible which is based on Modern-, and not original Paleo-Hebrew or rather Greek. The LSV Bible is a more faithful translation from the very same family. Ongoing promotion of the false name 'Jeh*'yah'; inclusion of the extra-biblical office of a bishop!	YES	
<u>Pentecostalism incl. New Apostolic Reformation (NAR)</u>		Total Rejection.		
<u>Progressive Christianity</u>		Total Rejection.		
<u>Prosperity G-spel</u>		Total Rejection. Good Christians can be poor.		
Religions / Denominations (Abrahamic only)	<u>Arianism</u>	Partly correct. CHRISTOS is long ago begotten in personhood, while eternal in His divine essence (no contradiction to THEOTES / Trinity), but ...  Total rejection of its evil fruit: -CHRISTOS is divine, but not fully deity- -HOLY SPIRIT is neither divine nor deity-	YES	
	<u>Armianism</u>	Partial Rejection. Most doctrines are biblical. False dichotomy that we ought to decide between this and Calvinism.	NO	
	<u>Calvinism (Augustinianism, derived from Manichaeism)</u>	Total Rejection; Cult(-like). Many doctrines are unbiblical; Fundamentally different Evangelium with a CHRISTOS who did not die for all the world. Mat 7:15 "They come to you in sheep's clothing". But there are some individual and sincere believers in the Reformed church.		
	<u>Catholicism (Roman)</u>	Total Rejection. False Religion. But there are some individual and sincere believers in the Catholic church.		
	<u>Islam</u>	Total Rejection. Largely plagiarized from Christianity (especially the Old Testament) and founded ~500 years after the NT was finalized in 120 AD. With a similar Abraham, but a distorted Father, Christos (Isa) and Mary. Indocination through the faked 'G-spel of Barnabas'.	YES	
	<u>Jehovah's Witnesses</u>	Total Rejection. Evil Cult.		
	<u>Mormons</u>	Total Rejection. Evil Cult.		
	<u>New Age</u>	Total Rejection. False Religion.		
	<u>Pentecostalism</u>	Total Rejection. Principal instigator of the Prosperity G-spel; Brought forth many highly problematic teachers and 'apostles'.		
	<u>Seventh Day Adventists</u>	Total Rejection. Cult-like. Many heretical doctrines; Additional laws to the Weekly Sabbath.		
	<u>Unification Church</u>	Total Rejection. False Religion; Evil Cult.		
Salvation	<u>Eternal Security</u>	Biblical Promise, but THEOS can (or rather will) retract if we reject Him = Conditional Security.	(YES)	
	<u>Foreknowledge</u>	Biblical.	NO	
	<u>Faith Alone</u>	Popular, but false Reductionism. THEOS contributes His grace, love, mercy and IESOUS' sacrifice. Our contribution to Past Salvation is to hear the Word, believe in IESOUS and His resurrection, repent from being a sinner, confess with our mouth and have active faith. Present Salvation further implies sanctification, making disciples and baptizing them, obedience, discipline and self-denial by putting everything second to THEOS.	(YES)	
	<u>Free Will</u>	Biblical.		
	<u>Grace Alone</u>	Biblical Concept, but not as stand-alone teaching: Grace precedes Past Salvation which involves the consent & active faith of man.	NO	
	<u>Predestination</u>	Not as stand-alone teaching and only in combination with Free Will.		
	<u>Hell (Gehenna), Physical, Eternal</u>	Biblical.	YES	
	<u>Hell (Gehenna), Metaphorical, not Eternal</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Salvation through CHRISTOS, offer available for 'elect' only (Calvinism)</u>	Biblical.		
	· <u>Salvation through CHRISTOS, offer available for 'elect' only (Calvinism)</u>	Total Rejection.	YES	
	· <u>Salvation through any religion (Universalism)</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Shipwrecking of Faith, Possibility</u>	Biblical.		
	<u>Once-Saved-Always-Saved</u>	Rejection. Eternal security is the promise, but we can clearly shipwreck our salvation.	YES	
	<u>Single-Tense-Salvation</u>	Rejection (The Bible teaches Past-, Present- and Future Salvation).		
	<u>Single-Tense-Justification</u>	Rejection (The Bible teaches Past- and Future Justification; see study).	NO	
	<u>Works of the Law (Atonement, Circumcision, Clean Food, Sabbaths of Sabbaths, Sacrifices, Tithing) = Works to get right with THEOS</u>	Total Rejection. Not required for Past-, Present- nor Future Salvation.	YES	
	<u>Works of Faith / Love (Giving, Helps, Hospitality, Service in church &amp; society) = Works after being right with THEOS</u>	Biblical. Not required for Past Salvation, but clearly for Future Salvation - then even judged and rewarded!		
	Spiritual Gifts	<u>Cessationism</u>	Total Rejection. Do not quench the SPIRIT nor undermine the functions within a church.	
		<u>Continuationism</u>	Biblical (But total rejection of the Charismatic Renewal (H. Bredeesen / P. Robertson / N.V. Peale) and of Pentecostal extremism).	(YES)
		<u>Tongues, as a sign required for demonstrating Past Salvation</u>	Total Rejection.	YES
<b>Important Symbols of Obedience</b>				
Baptism	<u>Optional for Past Salvation ('Born Again')</u>	Baptism can either accompany or possibly succeed Past Salvation shortly thereafter.	YES (Salvation Issue!)	
	<u>Optional for Future Salvation</u>	Total Rejection (With possible exceptions granted by THEOS only, not by men).		
	<u>Baby Blessing</u>	Biblical. Ideally in private and primarily done through the father of the child.		
	<u>Infant Baptism</u>	Endorsement of believer's baptism and rejection of systematic baptism. But rather abstain from speculation and judgment about what THEOS did not stipulate. Age of Accountability = 20 years!	NO	
Communion	<u>'Lord's Supper' / Christian Communion</u>	Joh 6:53 even describes it as a requirement for Future Salvation. Wine with or without alcohol. Bread with or without leaven.	(NO)	
	<u>Free-will Giving</u>	Biblical. 10% can be a vague orientation - Distributed btw. the poor / church / ministries.	NO	
Giving	<u>Tithing</u>	Rejection (Old Covenant Law = clearly 'Works of the Law').	NO	
	<u>Men should not pray with head covering. Women should pray with head covering.</u>	Biblical. We are the first apostle generation(s) after more than 2000 years of obedience. Paul proactively overwrote cultural prohibitions: 1. Creation order, 2. More authority for women, 3. Angels, 4. Biblical tradition	NO	
Sabbath, Weekly	<u>Saturday (Sunset Friday-Sunset; Jewish Mainstream)</u>	Not Biblical (Timing based on 2 out of 7 Feast Sabbaths), but possibly acceptable to THEOS.		
	<u>Saturday (Sunrise-Sunrise Sunday)</u>	Biblical. Weekly Sabbath.	NO	
	<u>Sunday (First Day, 'Lord's Day')</u>	Rejection. It is a -direct- product of anti-Semitism; see the study.		
	<u>Any-Day-Sabbatism</u>	Total Rejection.		
	<u>Lunar Sabbath</u>	Total Rejection.	YES	
	<u>Metaphorical Sabbath (Future rest only)</u>	Total Rejection.
